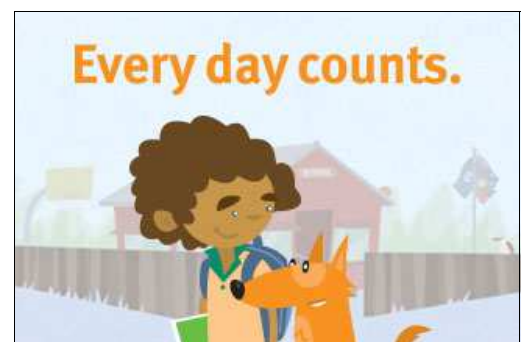
PARENT AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT
